George had a difficult but interesting life. For a long time, he couldn't find a well-paid job. He lived in Paris and London but he didn't have much money and he had to stay in poor parts of these cities. In London he even lived in the street for some time. These years helped him to write his first book called *Down and Out in Paris and London*, published in 1933. In 1936 George went to Spain to write for newspapers about the Civil War. Three years later he wanted to join the army to fight in World War II but he was very ill and couldn't become a soldier. He decided to work for the BBC and in 1945 he published *Animal Farm*. After the war he moved to Scotland where he wrote his final book, *Nineteen Eighty-Four*. He died in London in 1950. He was only forty-seven.
